



0-3 Months

- Tries to lift head when lying on stomach
- Hands are kept open most of the time
- Tries to hold head upright on her/his own while lying on stomach
- Rolls over from her/his back to her/his stomach with assistance
- Waves arms, moves body at the sight of a dangling toy

SOCIO-EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT (NEWBORN)

0-3 Months

- Stops crying when mother picks her/his up
- Smiles in response to the caregiver
- Reacts to familiar situations like bathing and feeding
- Lifts arms to greet familiar people

COGNITIVE DEVELOPMENT (NEWBORN)

0-3 Months

- Inspects surroundings
- Gazes slowly at moving objects/ people
- Turns head to bright colored objects

LANGUAGE DEVELOPMENT (NEWBORN)

0-3 Months

- Vocalizes by gurgling, cooing, and grunting
- Vocalizes to express pleasure or displeasure
- Turns head to bright colored objects
