SUBJECT Clarification on Means of Verification(MOV) for the
Child-Friendly Local Government Audit (CFLGA)
Sub-Indicator 2.2.2 – Percentage of Accredited or
Recognized Center-Based ECCD Services

The Early Childhood Care and Development (ECCD) Council recognizes the ongoing challenge faced by local government units (LGUs) due to the limited availability of external evaluators. To address this concern, this advisory reaffirms the provisions outlined in the CFLGA Handbook and offers guidance on alternative documentation. Specifically, if an LGU reports that the lack of recognized/accredited Child Development Centers (CDCs) and Learning Centers (LCs) is due to the unavailability of external evaluators, the Inter-Agency Monitoring Task Force (IMTF) can consider the following as valid Means of Verification (MOVs):

- 1. Results of Internal Assessments** – The assessment results validated by the Local Social Welfare and Development Office (LSWDO) and/or the ECCD Focal Person, in coordination with the Child Development Teacher/Worker (CDT/W) or the Administrator/Principal/Director of public or private CDCs/LCs, may serve as supporting documentation.
- 2. Proof of Request for External Assessment** – Documentation showing that the LGU has formally requested an external assessment and the reason for the delay in the site visit, should be presented.

LGUs are encouraged to ensure that these documents are properly maintained and readily available for review during the CFLGA assessment process. For further inquiries, LGUs may coordinate with the appropriate CFLGA focal persons or email standards@eccdcouncil.gov.ph.
